DLE Factors are designed to capture the experiences and outcomes institutions are often interested in understanding, but present a measurement challenge because of their complex and multifacted nature. To measure these broad underlying concepts, we use confirmatory factor analysis (CFA) to combine individual survey items into global measures that capture these areas. Factors are particularly useful for benchmarking; they allow you to determmine if the experiences and outcomes for your students difier from your comparison groups.


Sense of Belonging measures the extent to which students feel a sense of academic and social integration on campus,
